

Gift Aid

The Gift Aid scheme is for gifts of money by individuals who pay UK tax on income from work or savings. Gift Aid donations are regarded as having basic rate tax deducted. Swindon Panel Society takes your donation and reclaims basic rate tax from HM Revenue & Customs (HMRC) on its 'gross' equivalent - the amount before basic rate tax was deducted.

For every £1 you give, HMRC make that up £1.25 and send us the extra 25p. If you give £10 using Gift Aid, it's worth £12.50 to Swindon Panel. The amount you pay is not altered.

Please treat as Gift Aid donations all qualifying gifts of money made by me in the past 4 years and from today onwards. I confirm I have paid or will pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax for each year (6 April to 5 April) that is at least equal to the amount of tax that all the charities or Community Amateur Sports Clubs that I donate to will reclaim on my gifts for that year. I understand that other taxes such as VAT and Council Tax to not qualify. I understand the charity will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 that I give and that if I pay less Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax than the amount of Gift Aid claimed on all my donations in that tax year it is my responsibility to pay any difference. I will notify the charity if I wish to cancel this declaration, change my name or address or no longer pay sufficient tax on my income and/or capital gains.
